After residency, he completed an intensive one-year Fellowship in Interventional Pain Management and Sports Medicine at OSS Health in York, Pennsylvania. With his training complete, he moved back to the Chicago area and joined M&M Orthopedics in 2012, which became part of DMG in 2013.

In addition to his schooling, Dr. Fetzer is a member of the International Spinal Injection Society, the American Academy of Pain Medicine, the American Society of Interventional Pain Physicians, the American Association of Neuromuscular & Electrodiagnostic Medicine and the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

He is affiliated with Edward, Elmhurst and Advocate Good Samaritan Hospitals. Focusing on patients across the entire DMG service area, Dr. Fetzer helps patients improve their function by reducing pain from conditions related to their spines, joints or nerves.
