A board-certified, fellowship-trained orthopaedic surgeon, Dr. Ibrahim has medical interests in scoliosis treatment, spine deformities, and adult spine conditions and diseases (with the exception of the cervical spine). Also, Dr. Ibrahim's additional medical interests include: pediatric orthopaedics in club feet treatment, congenital hip dysplasia treatment, hip disease, spine deformities and trauma related injuries.

Dr. Ibrahim is a member of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, the American Orthopaedic Association, the International Society of Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology, the Pediatric Orthopaedic Society of North America, the Scoliosis Research Society amongst others.
